



EUROPACK Specification Management

Creation and care of your technical-logistic specifications for packages and technical installations in the lubricants and chemical-technical fields.

Creation of detailed and comprehensive technical descriptions of all important package and machine components. They generally exceed to a large extent the specification which is normally made available by the supplier.

Aims:

- Creation of a high Transparency (also cost transparency) with regard to package components (esp. labels)
- Permanent Availability of actual and complete package information (materials, dimensions, weights, tolerances, etc.)
- Creation of binding technical specifications for the supplier (the specifications generally become part of the contract)
- Creation of a basis of an (independent) Quality Management and a simplified clarification of quality questions and claims (decrease of the quality costs)
- Creation of a basis for tenders
- Independence from suppliers thanks to transparent and transferrable information
- Creation of the required Basis for Optimizations (standardisations, improvement of quality, cost reduction, projects of globalisation, etc.)

Contents of the Specifications:

- General technical description (dimensions, weights, materials, function, etc.)
- Detailed technical description of the individual components
- Quality requirements, performance requirements and tolerances
- Visualisation by technical drawings, graphs, artworks and photos
- Technical-logistic information (delivery logistics, warehouse conditions)

Specifiable Articles and Equipments:

- Packages (small packages, large packages, bulk-containers, closures, labels, cartons, pallets, etc.)
- Plant Equipment (filling lines, warehouses, etc.)
- Handling Equipment (pumps, discharge equipment, etc.)

Ways of the Realisation:

- Creation of specification documents
 - (a) on the basis of existing articles: „**Actual**“-Specification
by data collection at the suppliers and in the plants
 - (b) for future articles: „**Aim**“-Specification
by compiling the technical values which are required and usual in the market and by gathering the customer's requirements
- Reconciliation of the specifications with the (potential) supplier and, if necessary, introduction of working plans to the supplier to comply with the requirements
- Creation of a database with the specification data (with access administration, possibilities of access via Intranet or Internet)
- Continuous care of the specifications in the case of data changes (changes of articles, change of suppliers, etc.)
